

Texas Homestead Exemption

As of September 1, 2011, there are changes to the proof of residency requirements for homeowners applying for the property tax homestead exemption

All new applicants must provide the following documentation to qualify for the homestead exemption:

- Applications for Residential Homestead Exemption (available on most county appraisal district websites)
- Copy of Texas Driver's License or Texas ID Card. The address must match the homestead address intended for the exemption.
- Copy of Vehicle Registration receipt. The address must match the homestead address. Homeowners can get a copy of their registration receipt from the Department of Motor Vehicles. If you do not own a vehicle, you must complete the Non-Ownership of Motor Vehicle Affidavit (found on the Homestead Exemption application), and have it notarized and attach a copy of a utility bill showing the homestead address.
- The Homestead Exemption will not be allowed unless all the required documents show the same homestead address.
